Advanced-mastery Albanian

- Course focuses on Albanian for professional purposes
- Emphasis on professional editing, translating, composition, and stylistics
- Students work on both Tosk and Gheg
- Six-credit course held from June 22 to July 31 on ASU's Tempe campus.
- Classes held in the evenings and Saturday mornings

Instructor Linda Mëniku is a native Albanian speaker from Tirana, Albania. She is a lecturer in the departments of linguistics, journalism, and German at the University of Tirana, where she currently specializes in discourse analysis, Albanian as a foreign language, and media discourse. Linda has taught at the CLI since 2003. She developed the ASU study abroad program at the University of Tirana as well as the CLI Tirana practicum, which she directs.

- Lessons in journalistic, legalistic, scholarly, and literary styles of BCS
- Students improve their skills in writing, translating, reading, and interpreting in BCS
- Opportunities to work with academic experts from the region to complete an individual research project
- Study conducted in Sarajevo, Zagreb, and Belgrade for two weeks each
- Cost of tuition and program fees (excluding airfare): \$4,586
- Open to professionals, graduate students, and advanced undergraduates
- Tuition waived for all graduate students through grant from American Council of Learned Societies
- Competitive scholarships available for other qualified participants
