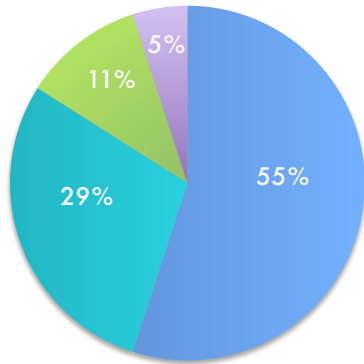

LEARNED SOCIETY REVENUE

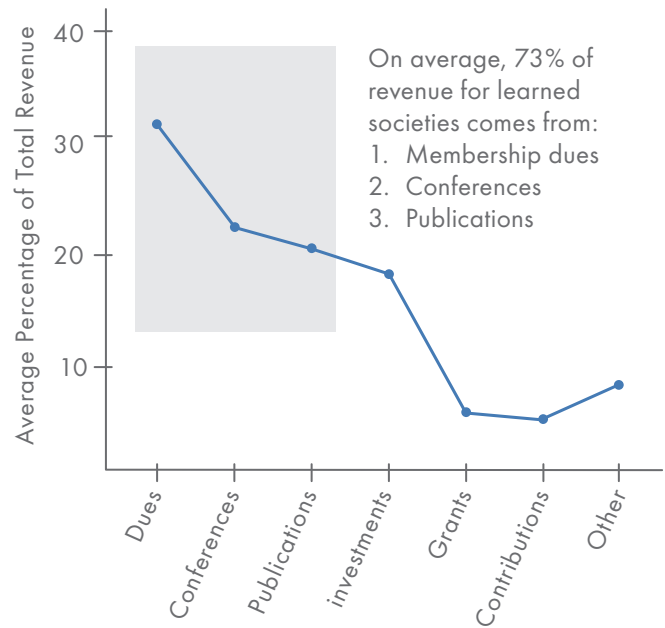
PREVIOUS FY ANNUAL REVENUE

OVER THE PAST FIVE YEARS, revenue has increased for 76% of learned societies, remained steady for 11%, and decreased for 13%.

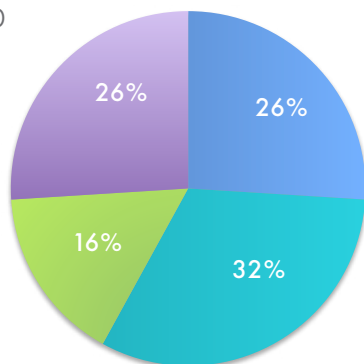

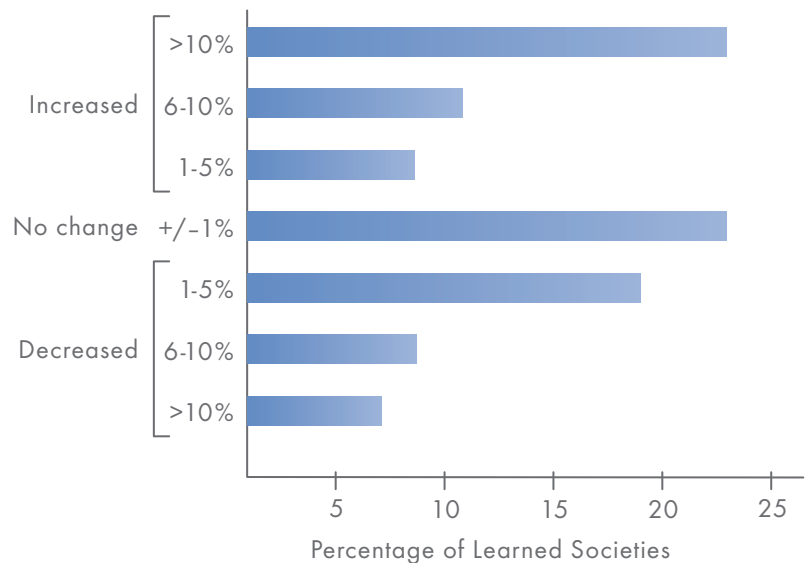

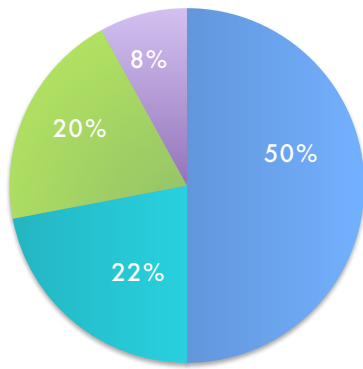
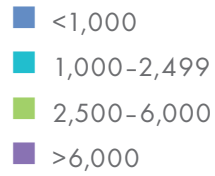
PREVIOUS FIVE YEARS MEMBERSHIP



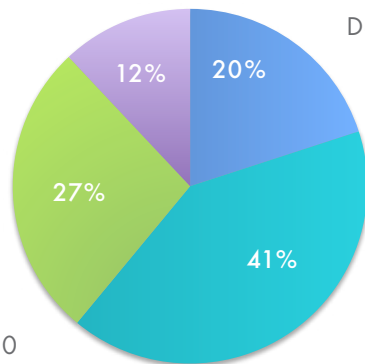
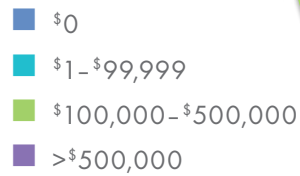
OVER THE PAST FIVE YEARS, membership has remained steady at +/- 5% for 51% of learned societies. Overall during this period, 42% of learned societies experienced a membership increase and 35% experienced a decrease.

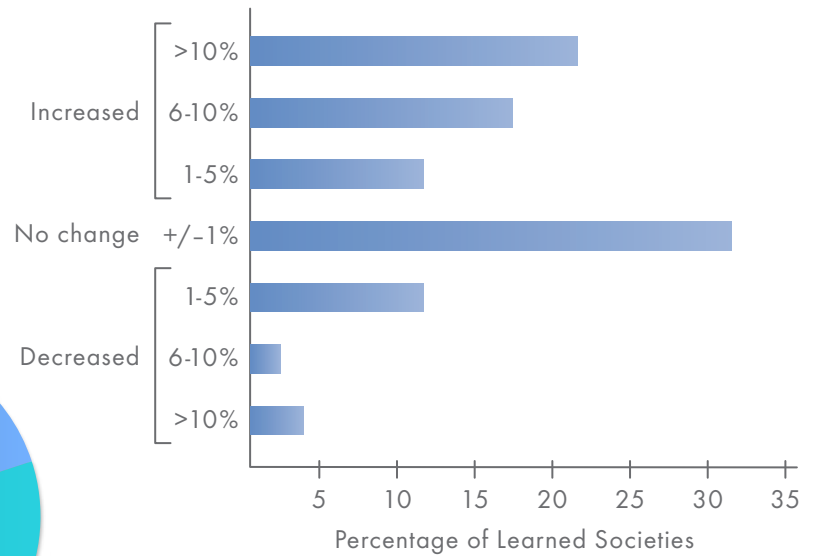
2014 ANNUAL CONVENTION ATTENDANCE



2014 ANNUAL CONVENTION NET REVENUE



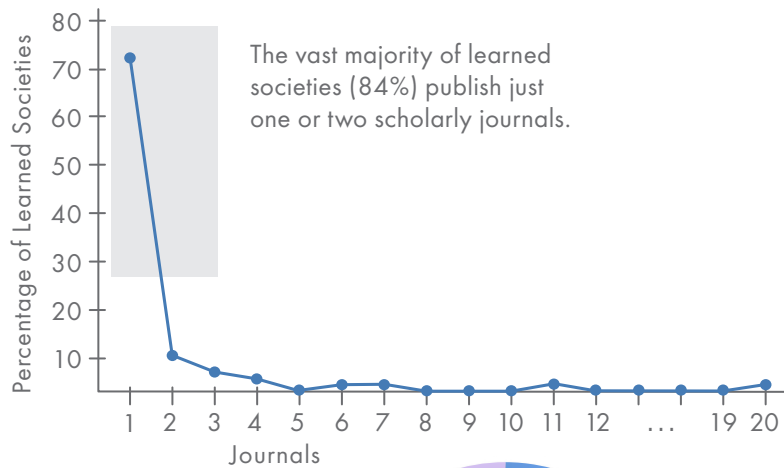
PREVIOUS FIVE YEARS CONVENTION ATTENDANCE



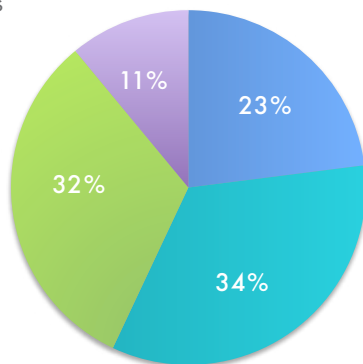
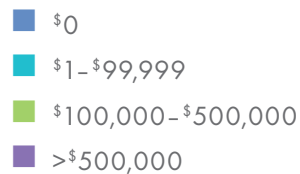
OVER THE PAST FIVE YEARS, attendance at 82% of learned society meetings has increased or remained steady, with 22% increasing by more than 10%.

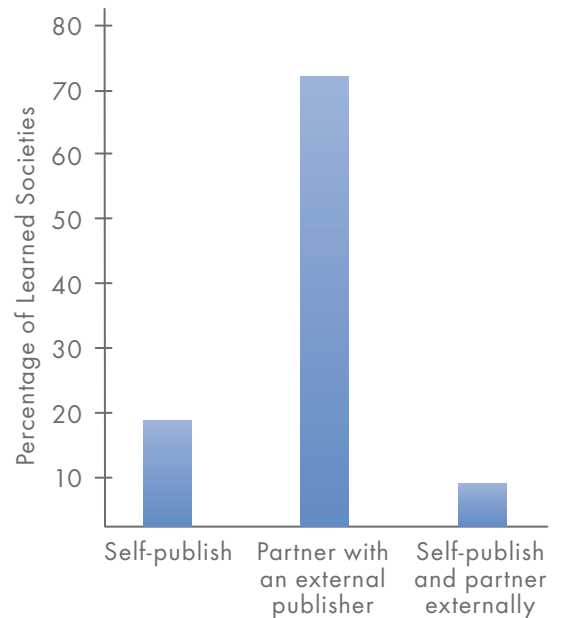
NUMBER OF SCHOLARLY JOURNALS



PREVIOUS FY PUBLICATIONS NET REVENUE

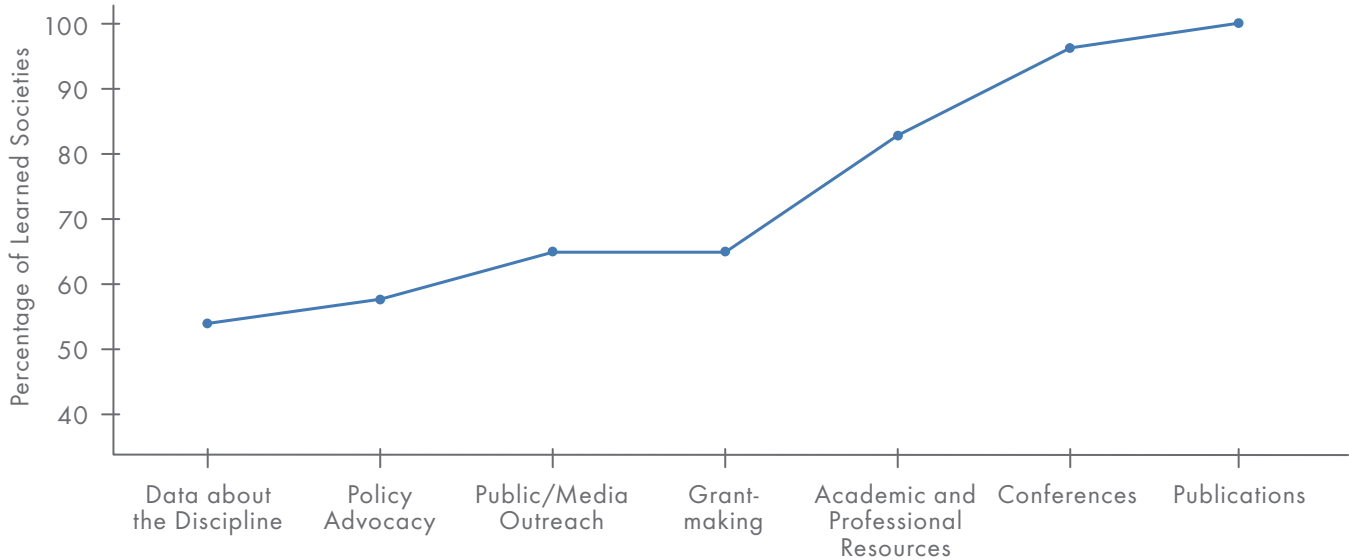

FOR THOSE SOCIETIES WITH A FULL-TIME EXECUTIVE

DIRECTOR, median full-time staff is 7 (range 0-45) and median part-time staff is 2 (range 0-15). Societies with part-time Executive Directors have median 0 full-time staff (range 0-47) and median 1 part-time staff (range 0-44).
